

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made on the basis of mutual academic and educational cooperation.

BETWEEN

FACULTY OF MEDICINE AND HEALTH SCIENCES (FKIK) UNIVERSITAS ISLAM NEGERI (UIN) ALAUDDIN MAKASSAR of Indonesia, established in 1965, an educational institution duly organized and existing under the laws of Indonesia, located at Jl. H. M. Yasin Limpo No. 36 Romangpolong Gowa, South Sulawesi, Indonesia.

(Hereinafter referred to as “FKIK UIN ALAUDDIN MAKASSAR”)

AND

FOUNDATION OF ISLAMIC STUDIES AND INFORMATION,

An academic institution based in Australia focused on advancing Islamic knowledge in interdisciplinary fields.

(Hereinafter referred to as “FISI”)

RECITALS:

- A. FISI is based in Australia and has expertise in interdisciplinary Islamic research, including applications in community and social development, including in health aspects.
- B. FKIK UIN Alauddin Makassar is a faculty within UIN Alauddin Makassar, located in Romangpolong Gowa, South Sulawesi, Indonesia. It focuses on Islamic-based medical and health science education.
- C. This MoU provides for the establishment of a general framework to co-operate in the areas of research, community development, integrated Islamic medicine, other collaboration between FISI and FKIK UIN ALAUDDIN MAKASSAR.
- D. The parties agree to promote mutual understanding, academic collaboration, and sustainable community impact through this Memorandum of Understanding.

1. Areas of Collaboration

The Parties agree to collaborate in the following areas:

- 1.1. Joint research and collaborative publications.
- 1.2. Expert and academic staff exchange.
- 1.3. Developmental assistance in program and curriculum designs.
- 1.4. Collaborative teaching and guest lectures.
- 1.5. Joint organization of seminars, workshops, and training programs.
- 1.6. Community development and outreach initiatives.
- 1.7. Exploring joint funding opportunities for academic and social projects.

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2. Responsibilities

2.1 Responsibilities of FKIK UIN Alauddin Makassar:

- 2.1.1. Provide FISI with institutional information and access to relevant programs and research opportunities.
- 2.1.2. Facilitate visits by FISI representatives, including scholars, researchers, and practitioners.
- 2.1.3. Host collaborative teaching and research activities in Indonesia.
- 2.1.4. Support arrangements for community outreach or pilot programs conducted jointly.
- 2.1.5. Provide in-kind support (space, coordination, local facilitation) where applicable.

2.2 Responsibilities of FISI:

- 2.2.1. Provide academic and technical support in the development of Islamic health integration initiatives.
- 2.2.2. Facilitate academic networking and collaborative research publication channels.
- 2.2.3. Assist in the guest lecturing and training of FKIK faculty or students.
- 2.2.4. Host FKIK delegations and scholars visiting Australia.
- 2.2.5. Assist in identifying and applying for international research or community grants.

3. Financial Arrangements

Each party shall bear its own costs associated with the implementation of this MoU, unless otherwise agreed in writing in a specific project agreement. This MoU does not obligate either party to fund the other.

4. Intellectual Property

- 4.1. Pre-existing intellectual property of each party remains the sole property of that party.
- 4.2. Intellectual property developed jointly shall be shared proportionally based on contribution.
- 4.3. Joint publications will acknowledge contributions from both institutions and be published under co-authorship.

5. Confidentiality

Each party shall maintain confidentiality of information exchanged or generated through this MoU, unless written consent is given for disclosure.

6. Use of Name and Logo

Neither party shall use the other's name, logo, or other proprietary marks without prior written permission.

7. Term And Termination

This MoU is valid for **five (5) years** from the date of signing and may be extended by mutual written agreement.

Either party may terminate this MoU by giving **six (6) months' prior written notice**.

Termination does not affect ongoing collaborative activities unless agreed otherwise.

8. No-binding Status

Except for Articles 4 (Intellectual Property) and 5 (Confidentiality), this MoU is non-binding and intended as a framework for cooperation. Specific programs or collaborations may be governed by additional agreements or contracts.

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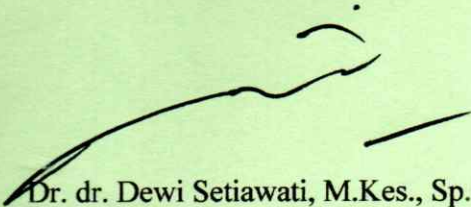
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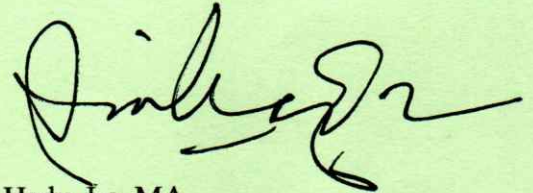

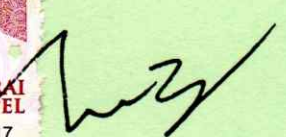
