

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

**K-MEDI hub (Daegu Gyeongbuk Medical Innovation Foundation), Daegu, Korea, conclude this
Agreement by recognizing the benefits to their respective institutions from establishing international links.**

1. This Agreement aims to develop academic and educational cooperation and promote mutual understanding between the two institutes.
2. Both institutes agree to develop broad collaborative activities in academic areas of mutual interest on the basis of equality and reciprocity.
 - (1) Exchange of faculty and researchers
 - (2) Exchange of students, other research and administrative staff
 - (3) Conduct of collaborative research projects
 - (4) Conduct of lectures and organization of symposia
 - (5) Exchange of academic information and materials
 - (6) Participation in exhibitions hosted by each organization
 - (7) Promotion of other academic cooperation as mutually agreed
3. Both institutes agree to develop specific collaborative activities to establish and strengthen research capacity in the following areas:
 - (4) Upgrading competitiveness to economic sectors for commercialization of innovations and medical products (medicines, diagnostics, vaccines and medical devices) to international standards that meet societal needs and improve the quality of life of the people
 - (5) Supporting and upgrading good practices in the discovery and development of medical products to international standards
 - (6) Forging collaboration in comprehensive research and development by taking advantage of shared resource utilization and enhancing the skills of entrepreneurs in science, technology and innovation.
4. The development and implementation of specific activities based on this Agreement will be separately negotiated and agreed upon between the institutes that carry out the specific projects. Both institutes agree to carry out these activities in accordance with the laws and regulations of the respective countries after full consultation and approval.
5. It is understood that the implementation of any of the types of cooperation stated in clause 3 shall depend upon the availability of resources and financial support at the institutes concerned.

6. Should and collaborative research activities under this Agreement result in any potential for intellectual property, both institutes shall seek an equitable and fair share as to ownership and other intellectual property interests that may arise therefrom.
7. This Agreement may be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the authorities of both institutes
8. This Agreement is valid for five years from the date of signing by the representatives of both institutes. This Agreement shall be renewed after being reviewed renegotiated by both institutes.
9. This Memorandum of Understanding was prepared in two authentic copies, both in English language. Each Party has read and agreed on the terms of this agreement and signed as in the presence of witness and each institution can retain one authentic copy.
